Discover Mauritius

Bonzour, Tou Korek? Hello, All good? Welcome to the island of Mauritius or Ile Maurice in French, the Jewel of the Indian Ocean. Mauritius is known for its crystal clear turquoise lagoons, pristine white sandy beaches, lush landscapes, and scenic views. It's paradise packed with history, culture, adventure, and natural wonders. Mauritius will enchant you and uplift your soul. It is a melting pot of cultures and cuisine, with influences from Africa, India, China, and Europe. Mauritius is home to 1.3million people and behind each smile lies the promise of a unique experience.

Ready for your full day excursion?

Port Louis - The Capital City

As the capital city, Port Louis is the bustling heart of Mauritius, where you can immerse yourself in the island's rich history and multicultural heritage, and enjoy the culinary treasures of our capital.



Place d'Armes (Arms Square), Port Louis

Port Louis' historical narrative is vividly reflected in its Old Town area, where colonial buildings blend with modern structures, encapsulating the city's evolution over centuries. Place d'Armes, the Arms Square, is one of the most iconic landmarks in Port Louis. This historic boulevard, lined with majestic royal palm trees, serves as a grand entrance to the city and leads directly to the Government House, a stunning French-colonial structure dating back to 1738. The square is a testament to the island's rich colonial history and stands as a symbol of the nation's heritage. The Government House, with its beautiful architecture, is one of the most recognised buildings on the island and serves as a reminder of Mauritius' French colonial past.

One of the most notable features of the Arms Square is the collection of statues that pay tribute to some of the most influential figures in Mauritian history. The statue of Queen Victoria, portrayed in her typically stern and regal manner, reflects the island's ties to the British Empire. At the opposite end of the avenue, near the waterfront, stands the statue of Mahé de Labourdonnais, a dynamic colonial French governor whose leadership greatly influenced the development of Mauritius. His statue has become an emblem of Port Louis and is recognised throughout the island.



La Citadel (Fort Adelaide), Port Louis

The cultural richness of Port Louis is further exemplified by La Citadel also known as Fort Adelaide, perched above the city, offering panoramic views and a glimpse into the area's defensive past. It is a significant symbol of early British rule in Mauritius. Named after the wife of King William IV, the construction of the fort began in 1830 and ended 10 years later in 1840.

The fort was initially intended to defend Port Louis from potential invasions and suppress any local revolts, particularly in the tense atmosphere following the French Revolution of 1830. Located strategically on a hill overlooking the city, port, and surrounding mountains, Fort Adelaide was crucial for maintaining control. However, by the time it was finished, the situation in Mauritius had stabilised, and the fort was never used for its original military purpose.



Today, Fort Adelaide is one of the few remaining forts from the British colonial period in Mauritius. Constructed from black basalt stones, it has been well-preserved and remains an important historical landmark. It now houses shops and serves as a venue for shows and other cultural events.

Port Louis Central Market (Bazaar)

The Port Louis market is a vibrant and bustling marketplace in the heart of Port Louis. Inaugurated in 1828, this is one of the oldest markets, a mosaic of life and colour. Also referred to as 'Bazaar Port Louis', the market offers an authentic taste of local life in Mauritius. This is where the locals shop. Stalls are piled high with juicy tropical fruits and vegetables and you'll hear the sound of stallholders echoing around the hall as they shout prices and vie for your attention.

Make sure you explore each section of the market. If you're feeling peckish, head to the street food kiosks for snacks such as samosas, dholl puri, and farata. You'll also be rewarded with tasty sweet pastries and a thirst-quenching glass of the island's creamy aloude drink.

Just outside the market, you'll find stalls selling clothes and bags, while the first floor is where you can pick up some locally-made crafts. The market is next to Chinatown and J, so take the time to explore the area's architecture and cool street art during your time in the city.



Le Caudan Waterfront

Located beside the harbour, Le Caudan Waterfront is a shopping, dining and culture destination in Port Louis. Its shop-lined walkway is topped with colourful umbrellas, leading you to the latest fashion shops and trends, a popular arts and craft market, known as the Craft Market, specialty shops selling unique local goods such as replica ships, Indian garments, locally fabricated jewellery, or art paintings from local artists.

The shopping centre also boasts cinemas, a marina, a bookstore, restaurants and cafes, the Blue Penny museum, hosting two of the rarest stamps in the world, a casino, and tax-free shopping options for tourists. You will also find the Caudan Arts Centre which regularly hosts Mauritian artists and international theatre productions. Another must-visit is L'Allée des Artistes (The Artists Corner), where artists showcase their talent alongside performers and musicians.

Despite being the first shopping mall on the island, Le Caudan Waterfront has been able to keep up with the trends and maintain its allure as a modern waterfront mall. Visitors can admire the workings going on in the port as large container and cruise ships make their way in and out.



Bois Chéri - The Tea Route

Forget the sunburn, skip the crowd – Bois Chéri, the biggest tea producer in Mauritius, is calling.

Bois Chéri is the first tea plantation in Mauritius and dates back to 1892. Visiting the Bois Chéri Estate is one of the main sites of the Mauritian Tea Route. This scenic trail takes you through lush tea plantations, colonial estates, and traditional tea factories.



You will travel back in history throughout this visit and get a surprising feeling of tranquility.

Enjoy the making of local tea and get to taste different ranges of tea produced by Bois Chéri while overlooking the verdant countryside.

Ganga Talao (Grand Bassin)

Ganga Talao (commonly known as Grand Bassin in Mauritius) is a crater lake, about 550 metres above sea level and 18 metres deep, located in the mountainous Southwest district of Savanne. On the shoreline sits a temple along with a collection of small shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva and other gods.

Ganga Talao is at the heart of one of the island's most important Hindu festivals, Maha Shivaratri. In local folklore, the Ganga Talao lake's history as a pilgrimage site goes back to 1887, when a Triolet priest had a dream in which he saw the lake's water springing from the river Jahnvi, another name for the goddess Ganga. News of this vision spread rapidly throughout the Hindu community in Mauritius, and when the priest subsequently visited the site with other people he found it looked exactly as it had in his dream. Every year since then, thousands of pilgrims have trekked to the lake for Maha Shivratri.

Maha Shivratri celebrates the god Shiva, one of Hinduism's three major deities. Pilgrims carry hand-made "kanwars" - shrines dedicated to Shiva, to Ganga Talao, and once they find a suitable place at the water's edge, they perform their own private prayer ceremonies with offerings of fruit, incense sticks and lamps.

Ganga Talao is a major draw of crowds in Mauritius, with many people visiting the site to pray, meditate, play with the local monkeys, or simply to walk by the lake and enjoy the gorgeous surrounding views.



Black River Gorges Viewpoint

Black River Gorges National Park, covering over 6,700 hectares, is the largest protected forest in Mauritius, home to a variety of indigenous flora and fauna.



The best place to have an undisturbed view on the gorges of the Black River National Park, south of Mauritius. It is a must stop location during a road trip from Grand Bassin to Le Morne for a stunning panorama. The vista point is but a 3-5 minute walk from the road and is really quite spectacular.

You'll be astonished at how elevated the viewing area is above the gorge below. There is a nice waterfall off to your right, bats and monkeys. The view carries all the way out to the sea. Keep an eye out for the pink pigeon and the Mauritius kestrel—two of the island's rare bird species.

Walking a path filled with souvenir stalls and smiling locals, you will be rewarded with a spectacular setting and an even more beautiful view of the Black River Gorges National Park.

Baie Du Cap - Macondé View Point

Between Le Morne and Baie du Cap is where you will be able to witness a stunning coastal view from up above on the Macondé View Point. Located on the south coast of Mauritius, Baie Du Cap is a small, quaint village. The region is well known for its natural beauty and its wild, rugged coastlines.



With the picturesque land and seascapes, encompassing the red-coloured earth, the deep green forest, the lines of palm trees, and the sparkling blue sea by the side- you will have an incredible journey to the viewpoint, Macondé. It is set on a curved portion of the coastal road, on the peak of a small rocky cliff where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the Indian Ocean.



Le Morne Brabant - A UNESCO World Heritage Site

Set on an unusually shaped peninsula at the southwesternmost tip of Mauritius, Le Morne Brabant is not just another mountain; it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that embodies the resilience and freedom of runaway slaves from Africa, Madagascar, and India during the 18th and 19th centuries.

It reaches 556 metres (1,824 ft.) above sea level, and its summit spans over 12 hectares (30 acres), with numerous caves and overhangs on its steep slopes.
